Step-II: submission of documents against the qualifying requirements enumerated below and Techno Commercial Bid.

Step-III: <u>PRICE BID</u> which indicates the rate quoted by the agency.

Qualifying Requirements of the contractors:

(i) Possession of valid VAT, IT, Professional Tax clearance certificate and Provident Fund A/c No., Service Tax Registration No., (ii) must have sufficient credentials for experience of executing similar nature of jobs having value not less than Rs. 10.00 (Ten) lakh done at least once in a single contract during the last three (03) years directly under Govt. Organization / Undertaking/ Autonomous bodies, (iii) must have also documents holding possession of Labour License and Insurance as per Workmen's Compensation Act for such job., (iv) Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss account for last three years. The completion time for this job is Seventy five (75) days from the date of site hand over to the agency.

The Step-II part of the bids of the agencies having deposited the requisite amount of Earnest Money in Step-I bid will be opened subsequently. Step -III i.e the price part of the Bids of the eligible tenderers will be opened after fulfillment of the qualifying requirements and the Techno-Commercial part in Step -II. The date of opening the Price part [Step-III] will be intimated to the successful bidders from the department in due course. All tenders including their various parts will be opened in presence of tenderers. The Earnest Money (interest free) should be deposited along with the tender offer in the form of Bank Draft/Pay order payable only on SBI SAGARDIGHI (Code No- 11377) in favour of "The West Bengal Power Development Corporation Ltd" in separate sealed envelope. No tender will be entertained without Earnest Money.

The Corporation reserves the right to accept / cancel any or all tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever. The WBPDCL does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender and qualification of tenderer will be adjudged as per sole discretion of WBPDCL authority. INFORMATION TO BIDDERS

This is a three (03) Step bidding system containing (i) Earnest Money- Step -I, (ii) Qualifying Requirement and Techno-Commercial Qualification Bid- Step -II and (iii) Price Bid-Step-III. The tenders will be received and evaluated by WBPDCL from technical qualification and financial point of view so as to make a selection in the best interest of WBPDCL for the complete work covered under the tender document.

Tender documents consist of the following:

1.

(STEP -I):- EARNEST MONEY: The Earnest Money of Rs. 27, 000.00/(Twenty seven thousand only) is to be deposited along with the tender offer in the form of BANK DRAFT/PAY ORDER payable on SBI SAGARDIGHI (Code No- 11377), in favour of "THE WEST BENGAL POWER DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION LIMITED" in a separate sealed envelope mentioning Earnest Money, tender no. & date of opening of the Tender. No tender will be entertained without Earnest Money. No interest will be payable by the WBPDCL on the above Earnest Money. Earnest Money of unsuccessful tenderers shall be refunded to them within three months from the date of issue of work order to the successful bidder/s. WBPDCL reserves the right of forfeiture of Earnest Money deposit in case the tenderer after opening of tender, withdraws, amends, impairs, derogates, or revokes his tender within the validity period or extension thereof.

- 2. (STEP-II): QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS:
 - Documents in support of qualifying requirement of tenderers as stipulated in the Notice Inviting Tender and further classified as below .The agencies
- i) must Possess valid IT, VAT, Professional Tax clearance certificate and Provident Fund A/C No. Service Tax registration No. & other statutory coverage,
- must have sufficient credentials regarding experience of execution of similar nature of jobs done having value not less than Rs. 10.0 (Ten) lakh at least once in a single contract during the last three (03) years directly under the Central or State Govt. Organization / Undertaking. Autonomous bodies incorporated under the Indian Companies' Act.
- iii) Must have Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss account for last three years.

- 3. Addenda to tender documents if issued prior to the opening of the Tender to clarify documents or reflect modification in the design of the contract terms, all such addenda issued shall also form a part of the Tender Documents.
- 4. Minutes of the meeting of the **Pre-Bid** Discussion to be held on: 11/11/2013 at 3-30 P.M. along with the tenderers shall be taken as a part to form the Tender Documents.
- 5. **TECHNO COMMERCIAL**: Acceptance of the Techno-Commercial Terms and conditions as mentioned in the Tender Document.
- 6. (STEP-III): PRICE -BID: RATE SHOULD BE QUOTED AS PER ENCLOSED PRICE BID.

7. Mode of submission of tender:

- All separately sealed envelopes containing necessary documents shall have to be suitably superscribed as 'EMD- Step-I' / 'Qualifying Requirements, Techno-Commercial, Step-II' shall bear reference to the name of the work and Notice Inviting Tender (NIT). Price Bid i.e Step-III will be opened later by intimating to successful parties.
- All the above three (03) nos. sealed envelopes [as mentioned in sl. no.7 (i)] should be kept in a common sealed envelope and to be super scribed with reference to the name of the work, Notice Inviting Tender (NIT), Date of opening of the tender and Name of the Tenderer, should be dropped in the tender box of CIVIL-OPH department kept in the third floor of the GM Building, SgTPP.
- Tenderers who propose any alteration in the scope of work or in the time allowed for carrying out the work or which contain any deviation whether technical or commercial will be liable for rejection. Conditional tender is also liable to be rejected.
- iv) The tender shall be submitted in person in the manner as mentioned above (sl.no.7 [ii]). Tenders submitted by post or Telegraph etc. shall not be entertained. The tenders received after the due date and time of opening is liable to be rejected.
- v) All the cost and expenses incidental to the submission of the tender, cost of Technical Survey, discussions, conferences if any, shall be to the account of the tenderer irrespective of whether the tender is accepted or not and the owner shall bear no liability whatsoever on such cost and expenses.
- vi) The tender submitted by a tenderer shall become the property of WBPDCL and WBPDCL shall have no obligation to return the same to the tenderer.

8. Opening of tender:

The tenders shall be opened in the presence of representatives of the tenderers at the time and date set for opening of tender as specified hereunder or in case any extension has been given thereto on the extended tender opening date and time notified to all the tenderers who have purchased the tender documents. Tenderer's authorized representatives (one person of each tenderer) may attend the opening.

The due date and time of opening of Tender (i.e., STEP - I & II) is on: 15/11/2013 at 3-30 p.m. After opening the main cover, the envelope containing EMD shall be opened first and if EMD is submitted as per norms the Qualifying Requirements i.e. Technocommercial part will be opened (step-II). Price bid (STEP - III) offer in original shall be opened if EMD of requisite amount (STEP-I) and qualifying requirement (STEP-II) in proper mode have been submitted by the tenderer later.
 Evaluation of Tender:

- i) Issue of tender documents will not be construed to mean that such tenderers are automatically considered qualified for the entire tender process.
- The WBPDCL reserves the right to accept any tender or reject any or all tenders or cancel / withdraw the invitation for tender without assigning any reason for such decision. Such decision by the WBPDCL shall not be subject to question by any tenderer and the WBPDCL shall bear no liability consequent upon such decision and the tenderer shall have no claim in this regard against WBPDCL.
- Evaluation by WBPDCL shall be based on the information and documentary evidence submitted by the tenderer in response to the NIT. The requirements as stipulated in the tender documents are the minimum and WBPDCL has the right to request for additional information and also reserves its right to reject any tender, if in the opinion of WBPDCL the qualification data / documentary evidence submitted by the tenderer is incomplete or tenderer is found not qualified to satisfactorily perform the work. WBPDCL reserves the right to reject any tender if the tenderer is found to be qualified by giving incorrect and/ or false information.
- iv) WBPDCL does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender and also reserves the right to split the work amongst more than one tenderer.
- v) Not withstanding anything stated above or elsewhere, WBPDCL reserves the right to assess the capability and capacity of the tenderer, should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of the WBPDCL.

10. **VALIDITY OF TENDER:**

The tender submitted shall be deemed to constitute an agreement between the tenderer and WBPDCL whereby such tender shall remain open for acceptance by WBPDCL for a period of 4 (four) months from the date of opening the tender during which period, the tenderer shall not withdraw his tender or amend, impair or derogate their forms.

11 <u>Cancellation / Rejection of Tender:</u> Any tender not accompanying the legible requisite papers/ documents as stipulated in the tender documents duly authenticated by the Bidder/ Authorized Signatory shall summarily be rejected as per discretion of WBPDCL.
