No tender will be entertained without Earnest Money. No interest will be payable by the WBPDCL on the above Earnest Money. Earnest Money of unsuccessful tenderers shall be refunded to them within three months from the date of issue of work order to the successful bidder/s. 9.	Evaluation of Tender :				
i)	Issuance of tender documents will not be construed to mean that such tenderers are automatically considered qualified for the entire tender process.				
ii)	The owner reserves the right to itself to accept any tender or reject any or all tenders or cancel / withdraw the invitation for tender without assigning any reason for such decision.
