Terms & Conditions:

1. The belts must be packed in wooden drum and shall be supplied in rolls of 250 Mtrs. each with tolerance of +2% to -0.5% as per IS-1891(latest).
2. Proper care shall be taken to prevent swelling of rubber from nylon plies and edge preparation shall be done with proper conditioning so as to get better life.
3. The successful bidder shall submit Performance Bank Guarantee equivalent to 10% of the Order value for a Guarantee Period of 18 (Eighteen) months from the date of supply with a claim period of another 03 (Three) months thereafter.
4. Other Terms & Conditions will be mentioned in the Tender Document.

Information to the bidders: This is a four part bidding system containing **Earnest Money (Part-I), Qualifying Requirement (Part-II), Techno-commercial Bid (Part-III) and Price Bid (Part-IV)**. Tenders will be received and evaluated by Santaldih T.P.S., WBPDC from technical and financial point of view to make the best selection for the interest of the WBPDC for the complete procurement covered under the Tender Document.

Earnest Money: The Earnest Money of **Rs.1,50,000/-** (Rupees One Lac Fifty Thousand only) shall be deposited along with Tender Document in the form of Bank Draft / Pay Order issued by any nationalized Bank from India in favour of **“THE WEST BENGAL POWER DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION LIMITED”** payable at United Bank of India, Santaldih Branch or State Bank of India, Purulia Branch.

Estimated Cost: Around **Rs. 65,00,000/-** (Rupees Sixty Five Lac only)

Cost of Tender Document: **Rs. 5,000/-** (Rupees Five Thousand only)

Qualifying Requirements (Q.R.):

1. The prospective bidder should have credentials of manufacturing of

- (i) Fire Resistant Grade NN Conveyor Belts of width 1200 mm or higher having tensile strength 630 KN/M, 3 ply, or higher conforming to IS: 1891 (Part-I)-1994, IS: 1891 (Part V) -1993, ISO-340 & CAN/CSA-M422-M87, Type-C, as applicable &
- (ii) Fire Resistant Grade NN Conveyor Belts of width 1200 mm or higher having tensile strength 1000 KN/M, 4 ply, or higher conforming to IS: 1891 (Part-I)-1994, IS: 1891 (Part V) -1993, ISO-340 & CAN/CSA-M422-M87, Type-C, as applicable,

in addition to any of the following criteria laid hereunder as on opening date of Q.R. during last seven years:

- a) Three Purchase Orders having value not less than Rs. 25.00 Lac each
or
- b) Two Purchase Orders having value not less than Rs. 30.00 Lac each
or
- c) One Purchase Order having value not less than Rs. 50.00 Lac.

2. The prospective bidder should have in house testing facilities required for testing of Conveyor Belts as per IS: 1891 (Part-I) 1994, IS: 1891 (Part V) 1993, ISO: 340, CAN/CSA-M422-M87 Type-C, as applicable.

3. Average annual turnover of the prospective bidder in preceding three (03) completed financial years as on the date of bid opening shall not be less than Rs. 200.00 Lac.

Legible photocopies of all the documents as stated below countersigned by the tenderer are to be submitted accordingly in a separate sealed envelope super-scribing 'Qualifying Requirements', Tender Notice No. with date, Due date of Opening and 'Name of the Procurement', otherwise the tender will be treated as invalid. Original copies of the documents are to be produced on demand.

- a) Credentials regarding Q.R. (e.g. Purchase Orders along with corresponding SRV copies etc.)
- b) PAN Card,
- c) VAT/CST Return,
- d) Trade License,
- e) Documents in support of Sound Financial Capability (if any).

Sale of Tender Document: Tenders Document can be obtained from Sr. Manager (M&C), STPS or his authorized representative against written application on any working day except Saturday and holiday between 11:00 Hrs. and 14:30 Hrs. after deposit the cost against the Tender Document at Cash counter, S.T.P.S. by cash only. Sale of Tender Document to the applicant will not qualify them automatically in Techno-commercial Bid. Tender paper must be sold by each of the applicants.

Opening of Tender:

- a) The tenders shall be opened in presence of representative of the prospective bidders, if available, at the time and date set for opening of tender as mentioned above. In case any extension has been given thereto on the extended tender opening date and time will be notified to all the prospective bidders who have purchased the Tender Documents. Authorized representatives (maximum two persons) of the prospective bidder may attend the opening.
- b) After opening the main cover, the envelope containing E.M.D. (Part-I) shall be opened first and if E.M.D. of requisite amount in proper mode is found only then Q.R. (Part-II) will be opened.
- c) Techno-commercial Bid (Part-III) of the prospective bidders who have qualified in both Part-I & Part-II will be only considered by the WBPDCCL for subsequent opening of Part-III at same or later date eliminating other participants.
- d) Price Bid (Part-IV) of the prospective bidders who have qualified in Part-III also will be considered only by the WBPDCCL for subsequent opening of Part-IV at same or later date eliminating other participants.

Evaluation of Tender:

- a) Issuance of tender document to the participants will not qualify him automatically for the entire tender process.
- b) The WBPDCCL reserves the right to itself to accept any tender or reject any or all tenders or cancel / withdraw the invitation for tender without assigning any reason for such decision. Such decision by the WBPDCCL shall not be subject to question by any prospective bidder and the WBPDCCL shall bear no liability consequent upon such decision and the prospective bidders shall have no claim in this regard against the WBPDCCL.
- c) Evaluation by the WBPDCCL shall be based on the information and documentary evidence submitted by the prospective bidders in response to the tender documents. The requirements as stipulated in the tender notice and documents are the minimum and the WBPDCCL has the right to request for additional information. The WBPDCCL reserves the right to reject any tender, if in the opinion of the WBPDCCL the qualification data / documentary evidence submitted by the prospective bidders are incomplete or prospective bidders are found not qualified to satisfactorily perform the job. The WBPDCCL reserve the right to reject any tender if the prospective bidder is found to be disqualified by giving incorrect and / or false information.
- d) The WBPDCCL does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender and also reserves the right to split the procurement amongst more than one prospective bidder and also reserves the right to reject any or all tender or cancel the tender without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- e) Notwithstanding, anything stated above or elsewhere, the WBPDCCL reserves the right to assess the capability and capacity of the prospective bidders, should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of the WBPDCCL.
