- 1) Earnest Money: The Earnest Money of Rs. 2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lac Fifty Thousands Only) shall be deposited along with the tender papers in the form of Bank Draft / Pay Order in favour of "THE WEST BENGAL POWER DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION LIMITED" payable at Santaldih or Purulia Branch.
- 2) A) Total financial involvement: Rs. 1.2 Crore (One Crore Fifty Lacs) approximately for One Year. B) Contract Period: One Year.
- 3) <u>Cost of Tender Paper</u>: Rs. 5,000.00 (Rupees Five Thousand Only).

4) Eligible Criteria / Credential:

(A) Technical:-

- i) The vendor should have adequately experienced to carry out the similar type of work directly under the Government / Quasi Govt. Organization / Power Plant / any renowned Private Sector during the period of Last Seven (07) years. Any post bidding time experience will be ignored and cannot be added as experience.
- ii) The vendor should have subject experience as above in Coal Handling Plant jobs for a minimum period of two (02) years or higher, executed during the period of last seven (07) years in a Thermal Power Plant having minimum capacity of 210 MW.
- iii) The vendor shall furnish necessary experience certificates i.e. Completion Certificate and Work Order in support of their past experience as above.
- iv) Capability to control the labours with sufficient command and confidence.
- **Supporting document should be submitted with the tender paper in **Part-II i.e. Qualifying Requirements**

(B) Financial:-

- i) Party should be financially strong enough to carry out the subject job.
- ii) Capability of making Labour Payment within 10'th of every month without looking forward for release of bill from F&A Deptt., STPS, WBPDCL.
- 5) Sale of Tender Paper: From 09.10.2014 to 22.10.2014 on all working days except Saturday day up to 15=00 hour. Sale of tender paper to the applicant will not qualify them automatically in Techno-Commercial bid. Tender paper will be sold to each of the applicants. - 5.1: The WBPDCL reserves the right to cancel / accept the tender in absence of the documents at their discretion in case competent authority deems it.
- 5.2: Legible photocopies of all documents are to be submitted with counter signed & sealed by the agency. Original copies of documents are to be produced on demand.
- 5.3: The tender, Qualification of bidder (Part-II) shall contain the name, Residential Address, Phone Number, Fax Number, e-mail id of person(s) authorized to sign the tender for future contact.
- 6) <u>Pre-Bid Discussion</u>: It is intended to have a pre-bid discussion at this Office of Sr. Manager(M&C), STPS on 27.10.2014 at 15=30 Hrs. to provide any additional information and furnish clarification, if any, needed on the scope of work and tender documents. Any modification or addenda to tender documents resolved shall also be part of these tender documents. Parties not attending the pre-bid discussion are also liable to abide by the output of pre-bid discussion.

8) Opening of Tender:

- 8.1: The tenders shall be opened at the time of date set for opening of tender as specified hereunder or in case any extension has been given thereto on the extended tender opening date and time notified to all the agencies who have purchased the tender documents. Agency's authorized representative (up to two persons) may attend the opening.
- 8.2: The due date and time of opening of E.M.D.(part-I) & Qualifying Requirement (part-II) after 15=15 Hrs. on 30.10.2014. After opening the main cover, the envelope containing EMD (Part-I) shall be opened first and if EMD of requisite amount in proper mode is found only then Qualifying Requirement (QR) (Part-II) shall be opened.
- 8.3 : Techno Commercial (Part-III) of tender of those agency who will be considered qualified in view of Part-I and Part-II by the WBPDCL, shall be opened subsequently at a later date. The due date and time for opening of Techno Commercial part shall be duly intimated.
- 8.4: Price Bid (Part-IV) of tender of those agencies who will satisfy qualifying requirements and who will accept technical and commercial terms & conditions of this tender shall be opened subsequently at a later date. The due date & time of opening of price bid will be duly intimated.

9) Evaluation of Tender:

- 9.1: Issuance of tender documents will not mean that such agencies are automatically considered qualified for the entire tender process.
- 9.2: The WBPDCL reserves the right to itself to accept any tender or reject any or all tenders or cancel / withdraw the invitation for tender without assigning any reason for such decision. Such decision by the WBPDCL shall not be subject to question by any agency and the WBPDCL shall bear no liability consequent upon such decision and the agency shall have no claim in this regard against the WBPDCL.
- 9.3: Evaluation by the WBPDCL shall be based on the information and documentary evidence submitted by the agency in response to the tender documents. The requirements as stipulated in the tender notice and documents are the minimum and the WBPDCL has the right to request for additional information. The WBPDCL reserves its right to reject any tender, if in the opinion of the WBPDCL the qualification data / documentary evidence submitted by the agency is incomplete or agency is found not qualified to satisfactorily perform the work. The WBPDCL reserve the right to reject any tender if the agency is found to be disqualified by giving incorrect and / or false information.
- 9.4: The WBPDCL does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender and also reserves the right to split the work amongst more than one bidder and also reserves the right to reject any or all tender or cancel the tender without assigning any reason whatsoever.
