1. Introduction

The West Bengal Power Development Corporation Limited (WBPDCL), a wholly owned company of Government of West Bengal, having Corporate Office at 'Bidyut Unnayan Bhaban', 3/C, Block-LA, Sector-III, Salt Lake City, Kolkata- 700 098 will receive Bids for taking delivery of Fly Ash from the concrete silos of Bakreswar Thermal Power Station mentioned in the invitation for Bid.

2. Scope of Supply

- a) WBPDCL invites Bids as specified in the Bid Document for the supply of Fly Ash from all the Concrete Silos of BkTPS in the Bulkers/ Browsers/ closed containers who shall fulfill all statutory norms of State Pollution Control Board and MoEF.
- b) The scope of bidder under this tender is to take delivery of Fly Ash from all the 5 (3X300+2X1000) nos. concrete Ash Silos of the Bakreswar Thermal Power Station, as detailed in the bid document, in Bulkers/Browsers/Close Container.
- c) Total quantity in MT of Fly Ash as described above against the Power Station, available tentatively, is as under.

3. The Bidding Documents

The Bidding Documents shall comprise of following:

- Notice Inviting Tender (NIT)
- Instruction to Bidders (ITB)
- General Conditions of Supply
- Special Conditions of Supply
- Bid Price Schedule

4. Validity of Bids

The Bidder shall keep the Bid valid for a minimum period of one hundred eighty (180) days from the date of opening of the Bids.

5. Earnest Money Deposit

a) Bid is to be submitted with earnest money in a separate sealed envelope superscripted with 'EMD'. The value of the earnest money is as mentioned in Invitation for Bid.



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b) The Earnest Money Deposit shall be in the form of Crossed Demand Draft/Bankers Cheque/Bank Guarantee in favour of "The West Bengal Power Development Corporation Limited" payable at Kolkata drawn on any Nationalized or Scheduled Bank.

- c) Bids not accompanied by requisite Earnest Money, in a separate sealed envelope, shall be rejected.
- d) EMD shall be submitted or copy of suitable certificate bearing exemption of EMD should be produced. Any tender without EMD shall be summarily rejected except the case of EMD exemption.
- e) Earnest Money of the unsuccessful tenderers will be refunded on request to them in due course after finalization of the order. For return of EMD, the bidder will have to apply for the same to Corporate office, WBPDCL giving the reference to NIT No., date of tender, amount and mode of Earnest money deposit-all in a complete form.

6. Submission of Bids

- a) All separately sealed envelopes/cover containing necessary documents shall have to be suitably superscribed as 'EMD' (Step-I), 'Qualifying Requirement' (Step-II), 'Techno-Commercial Bid' (Step-III) and 'Price Bid' (Step-IV)' as the case may be and shall bear reference to the name of the work and notice inviting tender (NIT). Tender document having each page duly signed and stamped, should be submitted in Step III. Annexure A1 should be submitted in Step –I and Annexure A2 should be submitted in Step –IV.
- b) The tender containing the four separately sealed envelopes shall be submitted as follows: 'EMD' (Step-I)', 'Qualifying Requirement' (Step-II), 'Techno-Commercial Bid' (Step-III)' and the 'Price Bid (Step-IV)' shall be submitted separately and the above mentioned four nos. sealed envelope should be enclosed in a common sealed envelope and must be superscribed with Ref. No. and Date and time of opening of tender, The tender shall be submitted only in person to the (M&C) Department, in the Corporate Office of WBPDCL, Kolkata-98. Tender submitted by post or by courier etc. shall not be entertained. The tenders will not be accepted after the due date and time of submission.
- c) Tenders which propose any alteration in the scope of work or in the time allowed for carrying out the work or which contain any deviation whether technical or commercial will be liable for rejection. Conditional tender are also liable to be rejected.
- d) All the costs and expenses incidental to the submission of the tender, discussion, conferences if any shall be to the account of the tenderer irrespective of whether the tender is accepted or not and the Owner shall bear no liability whatsoever on such costs and expenses.
- e) The tender submitted by a tenderer shall become the property of WBPDCL and WBPDCL shall have no obligation to return the same to the Bidder.
- f) Proposal submitted in any other format than the bid price schedules are liable to be rejected forthwith without assigning any reason thereof.
- g) In case the date of Bid opening happens to fall on a holiday due to unavoidable circumstances beyond the control of the owner, the next working day will be the date of Bid opening.



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h) The owner reserves the right to reject any /all bid (s) which is /are not submitted according to the aforesaid instructions.

7. Late Bids

Any bid received by the Owner after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed by the Owner will be rejected. The owner will also not be responsible for late receipt of bids.

8. Modifications and Withdrawal of Bids

No bid may be modified /withdrawn in the interval between the bid submission deadline and the expiration of the bid validity period. Modification /withdrawal of bid during the interval may result in the forfeiture of the Bidder's bid security.

9. Opening of Bids

- i) The tender shall be opened in the presence of representatives of the tenderers, the time and date set for opening of tender as specified hereunder or in case any extension has been given there to on the extended tender opening date and time notified to all the tenderers who have purchased the tender documents. Tenderer's authorized representatives (up to two persons) may attend the opening.
- ii) The due date and time of opening of tender is **19.01.2016 at 14-30 hrs.** After opening the main cover, the envelope containing EMD shall be opened first along with the quantity bid Schedule as per Annexure-A1 and then Qualifying Requirements (STEP II) shall be opened if EMD of requisite amount and in proper mode have been submitted by the tenderer. The Step-II shall however be duly processed later on.
- iii) Then Techno-Commercial Bid (STEP –III) and Price Bid (STEP-IV) of the tender will be opened later on a separate day, whose Qualifying Requirements (STEP II) have been accepted by WBPDCL.
- iv) Minimum quoted quantity should be 1000 MT/month and maximum quoted quantity should be 50000 MT/ month. If any quotation found less than the required minimum quantity of 1000 MT/month then the bid of that party will be cancelled without any further consideration.
- v) The quoted price by the H1 bidder should be considered for 1st contractual year. Price in 2nd year should be 10% higher than the 1st year. Price of the 3rd year should be 10% higher than the 2nd year.

10. Owner's Right to accept any Bid or to reject any or all Bids

Notwithstanding any thing mentioned above, the owner reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, either in full or in Step or to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time, without assigning any reason thereof.

11. Owner's Right to Vary quantities at the Time of allocation /supply

The owner reserves the right at the time of allocation or during the period of supply to the successful bidder/bidders to increase, decrease or modify the quantity of Fly Ash from that originally specified in the bid documents without assigning any reason whatsoever.



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12. Notification of Allocation

The owner will notify the successful Bidders in writing by registered letter or by Fax that his bid has been accepted and will issue the letter of award (LOA) for supply. And the successful bidders shall give unconditional acceptance of the LOA within 7 (seven) days from the date of the LOA.

13. Security Deposit

Earnest Money deposited by the successful bidders will automatically stand as Security Deposit. Additional amount to be deposited to match 2.5% of quoted annual quantity @ quoted rate. Security Deposit will be released after successful completion of the job with a claim period of another six months from the date of completion of the contract.

14. Qualifying Requirements for the Bidders:-

Successfully completed of similar works of lifting of dry fly ash from silos of Thermal Power Plants with the Bulkers/Browsers/Closed containers during last seven years ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited, should be either of the following:-

- (a) One contract for lifting of a minimum of 80% of the annual bid quantity.
- (b) Two contacts each for lifting of a minimum of 50% of the annual bid quantity.
- (c) Three contacts each for lifting of a minimum of 40% of the annual bid quantity.

15. Understanding and Clarification of Bid Documents

a. The bidder is expected to carefully examine the Bid documents and fully satisfy himself as to all the conditions and matters, which may in any way affect the work or the cost thereof. If any Bidder finds discrepancies or omissions in the Bid documents or is in doubt as to the true intent or meaning of any Step thereof, he can participate in the pre bid meeting ,which has already been mentioned in the stipulated NIT. Any query for clarification in the above respect after the submission of bid shall not be entertained. After receipt of such



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interpretation or clarification the Bidder shall submit his Bid but within the time and date as specified in the invitation to Bid. All such interpretation and clarification shall form an integral Step of the tender documents and must accompany the bid.

b. Verbal clarifications and information given by owner or his employees or representatives shall not be in any way binding on the owner.

16. Notification for supply of Fly Ash

- a. The owner will make notification of allocation for supply of Fly Ash in writing to the successful Bidder.
- b. Owner shall be the sole judge in this regard.
- c. Bidder would be required to comply with all requirements of the bidding documents without any extra cost to the owner, failing which his bid will be rejected.
- d. Any deviation taken in the terms and conditions of the Bid Document by Bidder may render the bid non-responsive.

17. Bid proposal Schedule

Bidders are to quote their annual quantity requirement in the bid proposal sheets attached at Annexure-A1 (to be submitted with Step-I). The bidder shall quote the price in the bid proposal sheet at Annexure-A2.

18. Uniform Bid quantity over the allocation period

The quoted quantity requirement per month shall be considered uniform throughout the tenure of the delivery.

19. Income Tax Clearance, Balance Sheet & PF

Authenticated Photostat copy of the current income tax return, Sales Tax, Professional Tax, Service Tax registration certificate, Provident Fund Registration Certificate, P.F.code number (as admissible) & the audited balance sheets showing the business turnover and Profit & Loss Account for the last three financial years should also be submitted along with the proposal.

20. Check List

- a. The bidders are requested to duly fill in the check list enclosed at Annexure-C.
- b. The checklist gives only certain important items, to facilitate the bidder to make sure that necessary data / information is provided by him in this proposal. This, however, does not relieve the bidder of his responsibility to make sure that his proposal is otherwise complete in all respect.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF SUPPLY

21. Acquaintances of local conditions

It will be imperative for the bidder to fully inform himself of all local conditions and factors, which shall have any effect on the execution of the work covered under these documents and specifications.



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22. Language of the Contract

1. All bids shall be prepared in English language by writing, typing or printing with indelible ink in

the format given in the bid price schedule attached in the tender document and shall be signed by

the Bidder or a person or persons duly authorized by the bidder to do so as per provision of contract. The letter of authorization shall be indicated by written Power of Attorney, which

be furnished along with the Bid.

2. Any interlineations, erasures, or overwriting to correct errors made by the Bidder should be initialed by the person or persons signing the Bid.

23. Confidentiality

- 1. Information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation, and comparison of bids, and recommendations for allocation shall not be disclosed to bidders or any other person not Officially concerned with such process.
- 2. Any effort by the bidder to influence the Owner in the evaluation of his bid, bid comparison, or allocation decisions shall result in the rejection of his bid.

24. Examination of Bids and Determination of Responsibilities

- 1. The owner will examine the bids to determine whether they are complete, whether any computational errors have been made, whether the documents have been properly signed and whether the bids are in conformity with the GCC/ or information to bidder.
- 2. The owner reserves the right to consider any minor informality, non-conformity provided such consideration does not prejudice or affect relative ranking of any bidder.

25. Correction of Arithmetical errors

- 1. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures for the quantity or price of Fly Ash required as mentioned in bid price schedule, then the quantity or price written in words shall prevail.
- 2. If a bidder does not accept the above correction of errors, his bid will be rejected and his bid security shall be forfeited.

26. Insurance

The bidder shall be fully responsible for maintaining all the insurances as per law of land at his cost.

27. Suspension of the supply

- 1. The Owner reserves the right to suspend and reinstate execution of the whole or any Step of the supply at any point of time.
- 2. The Owner shall not be responsible for any liabilities for suspension of issue of Fly Ash or issue of reduced quantity of Fly Ash for any reason whatsoever.

28. Indemnity for defense of Suits

If any action in court is brought by third Steps against the owner or an officer or agent of the owner for the failure or neglect on the Step of the buyer to perform any acts, matters, covenants or things under the Contract, or for damage or injury caused by the alleged



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omission/ commission or negligence on the Step of the buyer, his agents, representatives or his sub-contractors, workmen, suppliers, or representative of employees the buyer shall in such cases indemnify and keep the supplier and WBPDCL and/or its representatives harmless from all losses, damages, claims, expenses or decrees arising out of such action.

29. Recovery of Sums Due

Whenever any claim for the payment of the sum of money arises against the buyer, the owner Shall be entitled to recover such sum by appropriating in whole or in Step, from advance deposited against lifting of fly ash and/or the security deposit.

30. Safety Requirements

The buyer shall ensure safety and security of all its personnel, working at different places in connection with this supply and shall be fully responsible for the same. All safety tools and Tackles required like helmets, goggles, gas masks, respiratory masks, gumboots, shoes, safety belts etc wherever required shall be provided by the bidder. The buyer shall also ensure safety and security of all WBPDCL and its delivery personnel at delivery site.

31. Disorderly Conduct

The buyer shall at all times take all reasonable precautions to prevent any unlawful, notorious or disorderly conduct by or amongst the buyer's staff and labour and for the preservation of peace and protection of persons and property in the neighborhood of the delivery site against the same.

32. Delivery

Fly Ash will be supplied from the respective TPS as per direction of the Controlling Officer or his authorized representative.

33. Jurisdiction of Court

Kolkata High courts shall have the exclusive jurisdiction in all the matters concerning the supply.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF SUPPLY

34. Source of Fly Ash

- 1. Source of Fly Ash of the Power Station and its respective location details are given in 'Instructions to Bidder'
- 2. WBPDCL, Bakreswar Thermal Power Station is having state of art coal mills and pulverized coal \ Fired boiler. The Fly Ash generated from boiler is collected at its Electro Static Precipitators (ESP). The Fly ash accumulated at ESP hoppers are evacuated through its ash extraction and collection systems in silos situated inside the plant periphery.

35. Scope of Supply

a) Owner shall make available allocated quantity as per agreed delivery schedule subject to Availability and Force Majeure conditions like natural phenomena including weather conditions, floods, drought, earthquakes and epidemic.

Failure to take delivery of dry ash from the silos in any conditions other than availability, Force Majeure conditions and unplanned outage shall be attributable to the buyer, in which case cl. No. 49 shall be applicable.



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b) The owner reserves the right to supply the quantity not lifted by the buyers within the given point of time, to any other Steps at the sole discretion of the owner, at any point of time deemed fit by the owner.

- c) The owner may extend the tenure of supply of dry fly ash to the awardees, based on their Performance observed during the stipulated tenure of three years as per clause no. 2 c, subject to escalation of the price by 10%.
- d) The availability of the quantity of dry fly ash for supply to the successful bidder (s) shall be subject to the compliance of the MoEF/ CPCB/ SPCB stipulations published from time to time, followed by various amendments.

36. Delivery Report

BkTPS would deliver Fly Ash from the discharge chute of designated ash Silo of the plant. Fly Ash shall be considered to have been delivered as it passes into the buyer's Bulkers/Browsers/closed containers at the loading point.

37. Quality of Fly Ash

BkTPS would deliver Fly Ash from the discharge chute of designated ash Silo chute of the Plant on "as available quality" basis. No claim in this regard shall be entertained by the owner whatsoever after delivery is taken by the buyer in their Bulkers/ Browsers/closed containers.

38. Upward Quantity Flexibility

If requested by the Buyer the owner may consider supply of additional quantity over & above the allocated quantity, subject to availability, at the same price prevailing at the time of delivery and at the sole discretion of the owner, within the validity period of the order.

39. Price & Bidding Methodology

- a. The Base Price of Dry Fly Ash is Rs. 110.00 per MT with a provision of enhancement of price at the rate of 10% per annum over the existing rate. Bidders are required to quote their annual quantity requirement and price of dry fly ash in the quantity bid proposal sheet (Annex-A1) and price bid proposal sheets (Annex-A2) respectively.
- b. Bids quoting price below Base Price will not be considered.

40. Methodology for Pricing

- a. Price chargeable to buyer(s) shall be the highest price discovered from the bids received as per the methodology described in Clause No. 39 in Rupees per MT.
- b. All statutory duties /taxes /levies shall be charged extra.

41. Evaluation Criterion of Bids

Price Discovery and Quantity for allocation:

Allotment shall be made on the highest quoted rate (H1) based on the minimum quoted quantity of 1000 MT/month and maximum quantity of 50,000 MT/month. The allocation of the residual quantity, if any, shall be solely decided by the WBPDCL authority.

42. Payment Terms & Bank Charges

a. Delivery shall be made against interest free advance payment in the form of Demand Draft in favour of "The West Bengal Power Development Corporation Limited" payable at BkTPS on any Nationalized or scheduled bank and the amount of advance shall be equivalent to value of off-take quantity of one month.



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b. Buyer will be required to deposit the advance payment by 25th of every month for the supply of fly ash to be effected in the next month. In case of any excess /less lifting in any month, the same will be adjusted in the advance payment of the next month.

- c. All bank charges shall be borne by the buyer.
- d. The BkTPS (Controlling Officer) will raise challan on daily basis and invoices on monthly basis and the same shall be made available showing the value of Fly Ash delivered, along with applicable duty/taxes/Cess etc. and shall be adjusted against the interest free advance payment made to the department of F&A, BkTPS.

43. Taxes, Duties, Levies etc.

The bidder shall be liable and responsible for payment of all statutory levies in the form of taxes, duties, octroi etc on the supply. Such statutory liabilities, if any, shall be paid by bidder extra at actual.

44. Commencement of off-take and Duration of Delivery

Commencement of off-take shall be reckoned 10 days from the date of issue of Letter of Award. The duration of delivery is upto three years from the date of issue of the LOA.

45. Weighment for Invoicing

Fly Ash shall be issued based on actual weighing or net load capacity of the transporting vehicle. Weight so recorded shall be considered final. Fly Ash shall be issued based on actual weighment of the trip based on computerized in and out weighment slip. In the event of outage /non availability of weighbridge, net average weight of loading of each browser/bulker/closed container shall be used. Weight of delivered fly ash so obtained and duly certified by the controlling officer, shall be considered final.

46. Delivery Schedule

- a. The supply should be made as per the schedule based on advance payment. In no case supply will be made without prior advance payment.
- b. Buyer should depute his authorized representative to the power station for coordination and taking delivery of Fly Ash.

47. Billing

- a. Owner will raise challan on daily basis and invoices on monthly basis and shall deliver to the buyer(s) an invoice showing the value of the Fly Ash delivered, along with applicable duty/taxes/Cess etc. and shall be adjusted against the advance payment made by the buyer(s) as per sl. no. 42 above.
- b. Owner has right to suspend the delivery of Fly Ash if advance amount is not received by the Owner within the required date and time and such suspension of delivery shall be on account of buyer.

48. Failure to provide allotted quantity

In case of failure to provide average quarterly contracted quantity of dry fly ash due to any reasons.

including forced outages of the plant, congestions, etc., the quarterly contracted quantity will be adjusted downward accordingly.



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49. Cancellation/Termination of allocation for supply of Fly Ash

In the event of off-take being less than allotted quantity in spite of availability, owner reserves the right to review the order for supply of fly ash as below:

- a. Owner reserves the right to cancel the allocation for supply of dry Fly Ash and forfeit the security deposit of the buyer in case the off-take by the party is less than 50 % of the allocated quantity on an average, observed continuously for three consecutive months. The party may also be debarred from participating in any tender related to BkTPS in the next two years.
- b. The WBPDCL also reserves the right to terminate the contract with the Buyer and encash the security deposit in the event of non-compliance of any statutory requirement, or pollution related guidelines and conditions laid down by any statutory body.
- c. The rate of off take shall be strictly monitored on monthly basis, to ensure whether it is proportionate to the allotted quantity and decisions will follow as stipulated at (a) and (b) above.
- **50.** Controlling Officer: The General Manager (BkTPS) or his authorized representative.

N.B: The terms and conditions written in the tender document and GCC & SCC should be followed. In case of any discrepancy between the clauses of tender document and GCC & SCC, the clauses in the tender document shall prevail.
